Yegon, Tarus win marathon: Kenya's Daniel Yegon retained his title in the full marathon event and set a new personal best with a timing of 2:11:52 seconds in the 7th edition of the SBI Bengaluru Midnight Marathon at KTPO, Whitefield on Saturday night. Ebesa Merga Ejgu from Ethiopia was second with a timing of 2:15:53 minutes while his countryman Getahun Tilahun was third at 2:18:58. Among the Indian men, MEG's Tripurari Singh took the title with a timing of 2:25:35 while among women, Kenya's Gladys Tarus was triumphant. Around 10,000 runners from 17 nationalities ran alongside over 150 athletes from the Indian Armed forces.
